

Beyond uncovers the astonishing events that led to the USSR's conquest of space on April 12, 1961, by cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin's orbit of the earth, just 23 days before the United States' first manned space flight. Through extensive research and interviews never before published, the author highlights the fascinating parallels and fierce competition between the USSR and US Cold War space programs- the Soviets under deep cover and the Americans in the world's media spotlight.
