

Choose from classics, newer movies, festival favorites, PBS kids' series, animated story books, and children's movies. And kids' programming is unlimited, meaning you don't have to use your play credits!

You can access Kanopy via your mobile device by downloading the app; by clicking the link on our website; and through Roku, Apple TV, Chromecast, Android TV, Fire TV, and Samsung Smart TV.
