



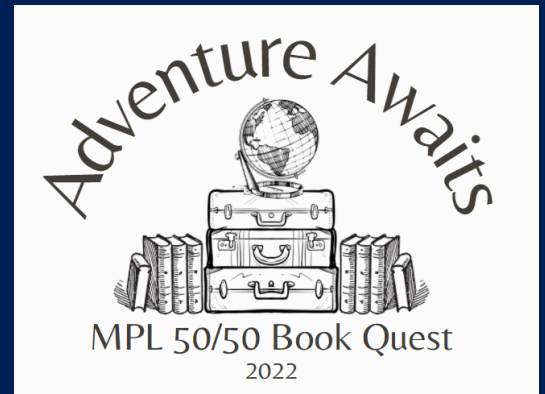

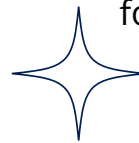

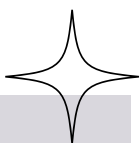
WHAT'S NEW IN THE LIBRARY?
