## FROM THE STACKS: "SPEAKER FOR THE DEAD" BY ORSON SCOTT CARD

*Speaker for the Dead* is the 1986 sequel to the 1985 novel, *Ender's Game*. Originally, Orson Scott Card intended for *Ender's Game* to serve only as a contextual prequel for *Speaker for the Dead*. Ender Wiggin, now 35, travels to the planet of Lusitania to research a new alien species and the mysterious deaths surrounding their discovery. *Speaker for the Dead* focuses on the themes of philosophy, anthropology, religion, empathy, and mystery.

This was the book that sparked my love for science fiction in high school, and re-reading it felt like coming home. If you are a fan of *Ender's Game*, I highly recommend checking out this sequel. -A. N.
