

☆ FROM THE STACKS: "ANXIOUS PEOPLE" BY FREDRIK BACKMAN

This is about a bank robbery, or is it? It could also be about a hostage situation, or about a rabbit. Backman writes, "This is a book about a lot of things, but mostly about idiots." What this story is really about is people. Anxiety is a theme throughout the book, but the story is also laugh-out-loud funny. What really made this an enjoyable read for me was the way he writes about the human heart. This book explores feelings of anxiety, grief, forgiveness, desperation, hurt, hope, and love.
