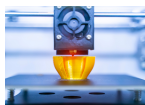

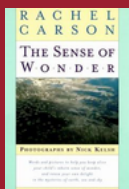

Rachel Carson, the famous author of *Silent Spring* and several other books about the ocean, had a young grand-nephew with whom she loved to explore the natural world. Rachel took young Roger to the ocean to wade in the tide pools and splash in the water. She always wanted him to retain the sense of wonder he felt about the great outdoors. She wrote a beautiful book that she described as, "Words and pictures to help you keep alive your child's inborn sense of wonder, and renew your own delight in the mysteries of earth, sea, and sky."
