

FROM THE STACKS: This Is How You Lose The Time War by Amal El Mohtar and Max Gladstone

This book centers on a trope that has captivated readers throughout the centuries: warriors on either side of a conflict who gradually realize that they have more in common with each other than with their commanders. In this case, however, the warriors (known only as Red and Blue) are timetraveling secret agents. The novella is written in an epistolary style, with each chapter representing a letter that Red or Blue write each other (part of the fun, too, is that one of the two co-writers writes each protagonist's unique voice). For a singular and romantic tale dressed up in science fiction, you can't do much better than this book.






