

FROM THE STACKS: The Way of Kings by Brandon Sanderson

If you've had your fill of "beach reads" for a while, you may want to settle in for an epic fantasy journey. I strongly recommend Brandon Sanderson's Stormlight Archive series which will keep you going for a good while. Book one, "The Way of Kings" begins on the world of Roshar, a richly populated setting, home to a continent filled with great variety and the savage Parshendi – beings at war with the human population. We are introduced to Dalinar Kholin and his family, leaders in this battle. We meet Shallan Davar, a young woman hoping to save her family's fortunes. Kaladin is an enslaved but brilliant warrior fighting for survival. Szeth-son-son-Vallano is a dangerous assassin. Sanderson creates an exceptionally rich tableau with an intricately woven complexity that is sure to entertain!
