2024 50/50 Book Challenge: A Book Tasting

For this year's 50/50 book challenge we are making a small change to the age categories. For 2024 we are simplifying to 2 divisions - the <u>Chapter Book Challenge</u> and the <u>Book Quest Challenge</u>. The Chapter Book Challenge will be for those 12 yrs old and younger with the goal of reading 30 books in 50 weeks in 30 different categories.
