RUDOLPH LOPEZ DISPLAY:

Eighty-two years ago, the armed forces of the United States on Corregidor Island in the Philippines surrendered to the Japanese. They had defended their position for more than five months with ever dwindling forces and supplies. Among the 11,500 troops that surrendered was Rudolph A. Lopez, who was taken to a prison stockade in Manila and from there to one of the hell ships, Tottori Maru, bound for Japan. Altogether, Rudy Lopez spent 42 long months as a prisoner of the Japanese before finally being liberated in September 1945. On display this month are memorabilia and information about Rudolph Lopez and his part in American history.
