FOOD FOR FINES:

Do you have overdue library books on your shelves? Now is the time to return that book, clear your fines, and help our neighbors in need! Marshall Public Library is excited to partner with The Idaho Foodbank for our 11th year to collect food and clear overdue fines.

Food for Fines is November 3rd– December 13th. MPL will forgive \$1 in overdue fines for every non-perishable food item brought to the library. Non-perishable food items are shelf-stable foods such as canned fruits, vegetables, meats, soups, boxed meals, pasta, and peanut butter. We cannot accept expired, home canned, repackaged, or perishable food.

Food for Fines only applies to overdue charges for returned items. If you have any other library charges contact us we are happy to help!
